



Julio González International Prize

This prize was established by decree of the Valencian Government in 2000 when the Governing Counsellor President of the Institut Valencià d'Art Modern (IVAM) proposed it. The award is given in order to honor artists' work over the time, specially for their extensive experience to stand out in the international artistic creation and their contribution to the modern art development.

The prize is called Julio González to tribute one of the most important 20th century sculptors, who, was able to create a modern sculpture with universal impact., the international award is especially significant as it is delivered sculpture: an edition of a figure of Julio González, 'Woman with Amphora II', cast in bronze with silver patina from a model and worked hand-cut property IVAM.

Also, the winning artists will be appeared in such an exhibition at the IVAM and / or a tribute act.
